### **Barney Bears nappy changing procedure**

#### **Inform a member of staff that you are changing a child.**

- Make sure the changing area is clean and all necessary items are to hand so the child is never left unattended.
- A blue paper towel should be placed onto the mat before changing.
- Gloves and aprons must be worn.
- Wipes provided by each child's parents are to be used to clean.
- Barney Bears wipes, if no allergies, can be used.
- Cream is only to be applied where a parent has given consent.
- When each nappy change is complete, nappy, paper towel, soiled wipes and gloves should be double bagged and disposed of in the designated pedal bin after each change. (Gloves should be removed carefully to avoid contaminating yourself and clothes).
- The whole area and changing mat should be cleaned with antibacterial spray and dried with a paper towel. If there is a spillage anti-bacterial spray should be used.
- All soiled clothes should be 'double bagged' and stored on the designated child's peg or in their home bag.
- Hands must be washed after each child is changed and a clean apron and gloves put on.
- Children should also wash their hands thoroughly after being changed
- Changes should be logged in the 'nappy changing book', recording child's name, date, reason for change and signature of member of staff changing.
